Note: Section 7 of the Wahta Mohawks Citizenship Code contains four subsections, each providing that certain persons are not entitled to Citizenship. Every applicant must complete each of the following subscetions.

Section 7(1) provides that a person is not entitled to enrolment if:
(1) A wife or widow who is not of Indian descent, who was enrolled by virtue of the Indian Act on marriage to a citizen and whose name was subsequently omitted or deleted from the Indian Register pursuant to that Act before this Citizenship Code comes into force (October 20, 2001).

(3) Any person who voluntarily enfranchised under the provisions of the Indian Act for any reason.

Section 7(4) provides that a person is not entitled to enrollment if that person is:
(4) Any person not of Indian descent who acquired citizenship through marriage to a citizen under the provisions of the Indian Act and who have since divorced.

I also understand that any citizen of the Wahta Mohawks may appeal a decision of the Registrar, and in the event of appeal, personal information relevant to the citizenship entitlement may be shared with the appellant, interveners (if any), Chief, Councillors and any agent representing these individuals. However, confidential information related to adoptions will not be disclosed, nor will the identities of any individuals included in my application or other confidential information at my request, unless this information is essential for the proper consideration pf the decision under appeal.
The registrar shall maintain all membership files and records in a secure manner, ensuring no other person shall have access to them except as permitted by the Wahta Mohawks Citizenship Code and Regulations.
I further understand that personal information may be disclosed to the Chief and Council, employees of Wahta Mohawks and the Department of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada as requested in the course of the ongoing management of the Wahta Mohawks Citizenship Roll and membership matters.
