Questions about the by-law:

- 1. What is the area Wahta members have rights to?
- 2. What is the opinion on the OMNR role in enforcement of the by-law?
- 3. Should enforcement of the hunting by-law be done by a person appointed by Council form Wahta? If so what kind of training should be required?
- 4. What is the definition of a Wahta member?
- 5. Does this definition include spouses and children of members?
- 6. When a member is hunting with a non-member does that non-member have any rights to hunting or are they required to have a hunting permit issued by council?
- 7. Should there be hunting seasons created or should there be no seasons?
- 8. If no seasons are created how do you protect species that are in a period of producing young?
- 9. Will there be a stipulation on restrictions for hunting of a specific sex of a species?
- 10. Should there be a maximum allowable amount of a species harvested for members?
- 11. Should there be a maximum allowable amount of a species harvested on a permit for non-members?
- 12. Should there be a position created as a wildlife manager for Wahta?
- 13. Should a wildlife manager position be created, will that person also be issuing permits for hunting and fishing?
- 14. Should there be any by-laws regarding species at risk? How will this be addressed?
- 15. Is there any need for a field data collection sheet regarding species harvesting?
- 16. What are the biggest issues concerning hunting and fishing on Wahta territory?
- 17. What is the geographic area covered in the by-law?
- 18. What about hunting on CP lands?
- 19. Does a permit issued allow for hunting on CP lands?
- 20. What is the opinion of the territory in which hunting is permissible for Wahta members?
- 21. If permits are issued how will this be done?
- 22. How many permits should be issued?
- 23. Will there be a lottery for permits? Will it be based on a first come basis or put into a draw for permits?
- 24. Will there be an expiry date associated with a permit?
- 25. Does the elder population have access to harvested animals?
- 26. Is there a need for guides on Wahta?
- 27. Should there be a requirement for guides?
- 28. If a permit is to be created what information should go on the permit? Will it only be a letter stating permission to hunt or will it carry much more detail about areas permitted to be hunted, permitted species and possession limits?
- 29. Is there a willingness to complete a harvest and hunting log?
- 30. How long should a non-member hunting permit last?
- 31. Should a hunting permit have a set charge for issuance?

- 32. If permits require a payment where should that money go?
- 33. Is there a place on Wahta territory where hunting should not happen?
- 34. Is there an area that hunting is the most productive?
- 35. Is there an area that should be designated as an area strictly for Wahta members to hunt on?
- 36. Should hunting permits only be issued to other Mohawk members outside of Wahta?
- 37. What kinds of rules pertaining to Migratory birds should the by-law have that are not already in the proposed by-law?
- 38. How should reporting infractions be handled?
- 39. Who should be overseeing the handling of charges?
- 40. How do you prevent people from making false accusations regarding by-law infractions?
- 41. What kinds of penalties should be enacted to prevent false accusations?
- 42. Will there be any opportunity for self policing of the by-law where a person can address mistakes made without being charged?
- 43. Should there be a segment pertaining to spearing? Members? Non-Members?
