COVID-19
Fitness Center and
Playground update

Wahta Mohawks is continuously assessing the situation with regard to COVID-19 and our fitness center and playground. We continue to follow the direction of the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit, our Pandemic Plan, the information and advice from our Federal Health Nurse and our Environmental Health Officer.

Following Ontario's lead, we are reopening our playground and multi-purpose play surface with safety warning signage. The signage notes that surfaces are not sanitized and contains the advisory regarding social distancing. Because these facilities are outside, they pose a lower risk of transmission. All users should stay home if they are sick, practice social distancing, refrain from touching their face and sanitize hands regularly.

The situation with the fitness center is different. The space is small so it would not be possible for more than one family group to use the facility at once. The equipment would need to be sanitized between this group and the next.

Unfortunately, we do not have the staff to control the number of people in the facility and to clean the equipment between family groups. The facility is also inadequately ventilated for multiple users. We feel that we cannot take the risk of opening this indoor space. We hope you understand the reasoning behind this decision.
